



## BURSARY POLICY FOR CERTIFICATE IN CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Each year, bursaries are made available to eligible participants in the Certificate in Corporate Social Responsibility.

### ELIGIBILITY

Eligible candidates for bursaries include:

- Candidates from not-for-profit organizations, who are not receiving financial support from their company/organization or
- Independent candidates without corporate sponsorship.

### BURSARY AMOUNT

Approved candidates are eligible to apply for bursary support in an amount of \$1,000 Canadian.

### APPLICATION FOR BURSARY

The application for a bursary consists of a letter addressed to the Program Coordinator, University of St. Michael's College.

The letter should outline the Candidate's circumstances, how the candidate qualifies and the amount of Bursary requested. A maximum of \$ 1,000 will be considered.

### WHEN TO APPLY

Candidates are eligible to apply for the bursary as part of their application package or after they had accepted a place in the program.

Candidates may wait for approval of the Bursary before paying their deposit/reservation fee, but must apply for the Bursary immediately (within 2 weeks) after receiving the Letter of Offer.

### APPROVAL OF BURSARIES

All Bursaries must be approved by the Principal and Vice President, University of St Michael's College. Awards may be made on a "first come" or "need" basis.

### NUMBER OF BURSARIES PROVIDED

In any given year there is a maximum of 4 awards depending on enrolment.
